First, two up-and-coming researchers will give tutorials on hot topics that we believe many of the participants will find beneficial to their research. At the demonstration session, nine internationally renowned companies have been invited to present their cutting-edge machine vision technologies. The representative from these companies will also meet students and other junior researchers at the Young Researchers Meeting during lunchtime and have time to discuss their work in a relaxed atmosphere.

As in previous conferences, three distinguished researchers will deliver inspiring talks as IAPR Distinguished Lectures. We would like to express our great appreciation to Professors Daniel Cremers, Jianbo Shi, and Hiroshi Murase for accepting our invitation in spite of their busy schedules.

We express our sincere gratitude to all participants and hope they find this conference enjoyable and fruitful. Finally, we would like to conclude by thanking all the members of the Organizing Committee and the Program Committee, without whom the conference would not have happened, for volunteering to dedicate their time to make this event successful.
