As in previous conferences, three distinguished researchers will deliver inspiring lectures as IAPR Invited Talks. We would like to express our great appreciation to Professors Tomas Pajdla, Johji Tajima, and Ramin Zabih for accepting our invitation in spite of their busy schedules.

We express our sincere gratitude to all participants and hope that everyone will find this conference enjoyable and fruitful. Finally, we would like to conclude by thanking all the members of the Organizing Committee and the Program Committee for their time and dedication to make this event successful.
